









ED Documentation

Documenting Interventions

1. Highlight the patient on the Tracker and click **Interventions**. 
2. Click the check box next to the intervention name.  
3. Click the **Document** footer button. 
 - Confirm the Timestamp at the top is correct. If it has been more than 15 minutes since the time you actually performed the assessment or intervention, then click the **Edit Date/Time** footer button before you begin documenting and enter the actual time you performed the assessment or intervention. 
4. Document the intervention.
 - On the Past Medical History Assessment, click the **Recall Values** button before you start documenting to recall information gathered during previous visits. Confirm with patient that recalled responses are correct.
 - A Text query means click on the box and type your response. 
 - **WDL** query - Read the WDL Guidelines. Select WDL or document what is outside the limits by clicking WDL Except and only documenting the queries that apply to the exception.
 - For a group assessment - Document by Exception. This means only document the assessments in the group that apply to the Chief Complaint. Select an assessment and document. When done, click the **Go to** footer button.  Repeat this sequence. When done documenting the needed assessments, click **Save**.
 - If a Treatment does not require documentation, only a **Date, Time, User screen** pops up for you to complete.
5. When done, click **Save**.
6. Result:  Documented interventions display a plus in front of the name.

Keypoints

- On the Interventions screen, the **Chief Complaint** sections under **Assessment** and under **Treatment** are populated with the required assessments and treatments for the selected Chief Complaint.
- **Green text means required; the intervention must be documented.**
- Look under **Physician Ordered** in the **Treatment** section for nursing
