## EMR (Electronic Medical Record) Panels



Return: return to previous screen

Other Visit: view information from another visit. Access Legacy system (visits prior to June 2014).

Special Panels: data from several panels results

24 Hour: past 24 hours data for vitals, I&O, lab results, other diagnostic reports.

Vital Signs: temperature, BP, pulse, respiratory rate, and pulse oximetry.

I & O: includes I & O source, e.g., oral, IV, urine, drainage.

Notes: multidisciplinary notes.

Medications: active, discontinued, all meds, last admin.

Order History: orders that have been entered.

Laboratory, Microbiology, Blood Bank, Pathology: displays data.

Imaging: results of x-rays, mri, ct scan, dopplers, etc.

Other Reports: H&P, consults, Periop documentation, OR documentation, L&D documentation, etc.

Care Trends: significant trended data grouped by body systems/special categories. (e.g, pain, education)

Care Activity: multidisciplinary assessments, interventions, outcomes, and plan of care.

History: patient responses to Past Medical History and Family Medical History questions.


Summary: Summary List - displays data cumulative to the patient record rather than for a single visit.

Risk/Legal -find scanned Advance Directives and Consents

Discharge: launches the Discharge module

Orders: launches module to enter patient orders

Reconcile Meds: launches module to home medications documentation

Click  to exit back to the desktop

Camera icon



Camera icon indicates that radiologic images and scanned documents are available for viewing.

If a row label cell is yellow, you should click on the row label, NOT the camera icon, to view all scanned documents (e.g., consents). Clicking the camera icon on the yellow row will only display the most recent document.
