Interventions Worklist

The **Interventions Worklist** displays tasks or actions that a care provider performs for a patient.

- **Frequency:** Required frequency of documentation (Click to edit as needed)
- **History:** Period of time since last documented
- **Next Scheduled:** Next documentation time
- **Prtcl:** Arrow indicates protocols available for the intervention
- **Associated Data:** Arrow indicates related data

Footer buttons allow you to act on the interventions. Ex. Click to select an intervention from the list, then click a footer button to document, document in spreadsheet view, delete, save, etc.

Intervention Types

3 Types of Interventions

- **Assessment:** A single form opens for your documentation
- **Group Assessment:** Multiple related assessments open; a Go To menu is used to navigate the pages
- **I Did It:** Notes only a time/date stamp to indicate completion of the task
