Verified & Unverified Meds

Pharmacy reviews and verifies the accuracy and safety of all medication orders and completes interaction checking.

- These orders remain in **Unverified** status on the eMAR until they are assessed, verified and the Current Status is changed to **Active**.
- Only **Active** meds should be administered.

Important: Hospital policy is that, for patient safety, you never document an unverified medication on the eMAR because unverified means Pharmacy has not completed interaction checking.

However, in an emergent situation, the system allows you to pull the medication from the Pyxis with an override, administer the medication, and then document the administration.

Always follow your ministry's policies and document the medication administration using the process below before your shift ends.
