


## Care Plan Documentation

### latrics Visual Flowsheet: Locating Care Plan Documentation (Page 1 of 2)

It is considered **BEST PRACTICE** to review care plan documentation before you start caring for your patient.

- latrics is available from the PCS screen and the EMR.
- It is built like a spreadsheet, with columns and rows, making it easy to read.
- Users can easily view interdisciplinary care plan documentation side by side.

Access the latrics Visual Flowsheet	
1.	Once you have a patient selected, click the <b>latrics Systems</b> button at the very top right of the screen. 
2.	Click on <b>Visual Flowsheet</b> in the drop down list.
3.	Type <b>CARE</b> in the format field and press enter. The rest of the fields on the screen will populate.
4.	Click <b>OK</b> ; you will see a few pop up boxes indicating the network is connecting.
5.	Once the system is connected, the latrics flowsheet will open and a message will indicate that the data is being loaded. This may take a moment depending on how long the patient has been in the hospital and how much documentation has been done.

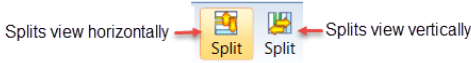

There is a row of icons at the top to the screen.

- The only ones you should use are the 2 which are titled "Split".



- The split function allows you to view to different disciplines' documentation side by side.

Below the icons is a row of tabs.

- These relate to the healthcare teams' documentation.
- The orange tab indicates the tab which you are currently viewing.
- Gray tabs indicate that no documentation has been entered.

In the middle of the screen, dates, time frames, and documentation will

appear.

- If there are past dates and time frames, a horizontal scroll bar will be at the bottom of the screen to scroll through the documentation.
