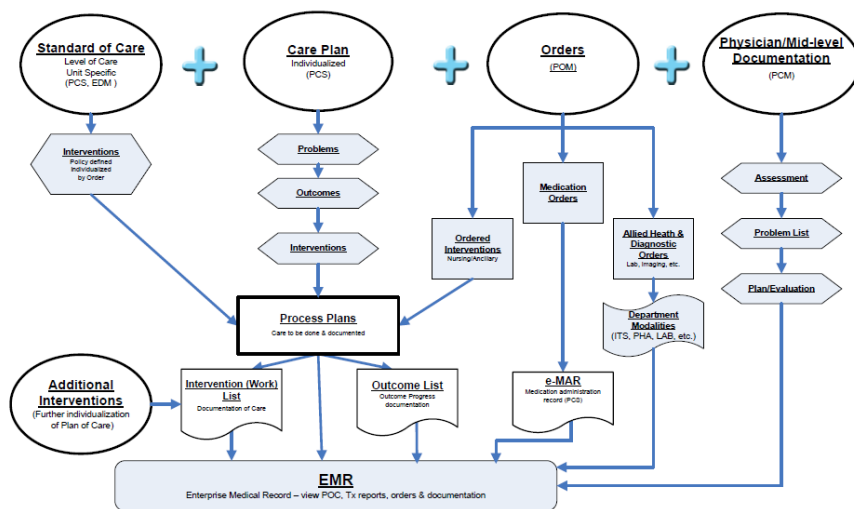


Care Plan Documentation

Plan of Care Overview

MEDITECH Interdisciplinary PLAN OF CARE Components

(Note: intervention = work = assessment or actual treatment or care)



The Plan of Care is an **interdisciplinary plan** that is individualized to the patient. It includes:

- **A Standard of Care (SOC):** A group of interventions and assessments which are based on policy and regulatory requirements for a specific level of care or patient population. These are initiated by the nurse on admission which eliminates the need for physicians to order routine interventions such as VS and I&O.
- **A Care Plan:** This is a set of interventions and assessments the interdisciplinary team will implement to resolve and support the patient's diagnosis or condition. Care Plan content has been developed based on best practice and evidence based practice. It is initiated by the nurse after completing the patient's admission assessment and modifies it by adding or removing problems, outcomes, and/or interventions. Ancillary departments, such as RT/OT/PT/Spiritual Care/etc., add discipline specific problems, outcomes, and/or interventions to Care Plan problems.
