Completing the Standard of Care

When a patient transfers from one level of care to another, the sending nurse must complete the current Standard of Care (SOC) so that the receiving unit may initiate a new unit appropriate Standard of Care.

Process:

1. Click **Process Plans** on the menu bar on the right side of the screen.
2. Click the checkbox to the left of the SOC name.
